You can look up information about where to find a geocache on the internet, so a paper map is not really needed. There are also geocache apps, which you can download on your phone. **2** ____ You might also swap a treasure in the box for something of the same or higher value, and then you return it to its original place.

A geocache is usually a small metal, wooden or plastic box that is protected from the cold and rain. **3** ____ There is also a pencil and a set of small 'treasures'. They aren't really valuable – a treasure can be a plastic toy, a seashell, dice or sunglasses.

It's a great activity to do with your school friends or family and is fun for all ages. There are over three million geocaches hidden all over the world in nature parks and cities. **4** ____ Why not have a look?
