And I don't think they are motivated enough to learn new technical skills.

3 Alex

I was a nurse but decided to change my career after ten years. I wanted to do something more exciting and exceptional – only 4 percent of all firefighters are female. That's too few! People need us. We are there to show patience and warmth for sick or injured victims. Just like a nurse but in more difficult circumstances. Another important quality is the ability to remain calm and confident under pressure. You must be able to make quick and smart decisions in an emergency. You also need to be able to follow instructions – there's no time to explain twice during a fire as it is often a race against time.

4 Michael

I've worked as a firefighter for three months now. I think the best advice I got when I started was to take the job seriously – you need to be sensible about things – and to remain positive, even when things start to go wrong. It's a tough job, and it's easy to feel stressed. Saving someone's life is a huge responsibility and often you don't have time to think twice. In order to survive in this job, you must take care of your mental health and you need to learn how to calm down and reduce your stress.
